

Further General Funding Conditions for a short-term stipend provided by the MIN graduate school international

1. The objective of a scholarship includes

a. For **A**): only the continuation of studies and obtaining the master's degree and requires the use of full workforce.

b. For **B**): The scholarship is solely intended for the processing of a dissertation or obtaining a doctoral degree and requires the employment of the full workforce.

2. If the scholarship holder does not comply with the obligation to work on the course / dissertation, this will result in the termination of the funding without further notice.

3. **The bridging and doctorate scholarship** requires a successful admission and enrollment at the beginning of the doctorate.

4. A **doctorate scholarship** in the final phase of the doctorate will only be given, if the successful completion of the dissertation is expected during the extension period (basics: consistent prognoses of supervisor and doctoral candidate).

5. Scholarship holder and supervisor should maintain close working contact. Please inform your supervisor, the relevant department administration and the MIN Graduate School International about all facts relevant to the funding of the scholarship (for example, completion of the doctorate prior to the end of the scholarship or reception of a third-party funding).

6. In a short final report (max 300 words), the scholarship holder documents the progress of the research project as well as the added value of the scholarship. Submit the report unsolicited with a brief statement from the supervisor at the MIN Graduate School International. The report may be published in full or in part on our own websites.

7. There is no employment relationship between the Universität Hamburg and the scholarship holder; Contributions to social security are therefore not provided.

8. Funding is excluded if the applicant for the same purpose receives different funding during the same period. Unemployment benefits and scholarships are also not compatible.

9. There is no legal claim to receive the funding.

10. After elimination of the eligibility requirements, amounts already paid must be paid back.
